Discover a new twist on an old favorite in this book by quilting teacher Kathy Delaney, who here revises and updates the classic Horn of Plenty quilt by Eveline Foland that was published in the Kansas City Star in 1932. Featuring 18 individual appliqués of fruit on the branch or vine, the patterns for the quilt were taken straight from the newspaper's archives and are reprinted here in their original form, followed by Delaney's redrafted patterns, dressed up with new techniques, exciting fabrics, and modern appliqué tips. The Kansas City Star was renowned for a widely popular series of quilt blocks published in the newspaper from 1928 to 1961, and still avidly sought after by quilters. These patterns and others inspired by them have been published by Kansas City Star Books since 1999. 164.
